CRC's On Tour Wild & Scenic Film Festival

This year marks the Connecticut River Conservancy's (CRC) inaugural Wild & Scenic Film Festival: On Tour. Attendees will watch a series of short films about environmental stewardship, adventure, and fellowship in the natural world. About Wild & Scenic Film Festival

The Wild & Scenic Film Festival was started by the watershed advocacy group, the South Yuba River Citizens League (SYRCL) in 2003. The festival's namesake is in celebration of SYRCL's landmark victory to receive "Wild & Scenic" status for 39 miles of the South Yuba River in 1999. The home festival kicks-off the international tour to communities around the globe, allowing SYRCL to share their success as an environmental group with other organizations.
